2. Each team member should research their article to answer the following questions, based on the team's given articles.

1. Who is responsible for the world's biggest omelet based on weight?

2. Who is responsible for the world's biggest omelet based on area?

3. Who is responsible for the world's biggest omelet based on the number of eggs used?

4. Keep in mind that the *metric tonne = 1000kilograms* and in the USA a *ton = 2000 lbs.* Which ton is article 2 talking about?

5. For measuring, does Canada use the Metric System or the U.S. system.

6. Why do articles 2, 4 and 5 use metric tones?

7. Approximately how many U.S. tons is 6510 lbs?

8. If an average egg weighs 1.75 oz. each, milk weighs 8.6 lbs/gal., tomatoes weigh 9 lbs/gal. How much did Crazy Otto's omelet weigh in pounds? (remember to convert to pounds)

9. The omelet made by Chef Carlos Fernandez, what was the average weight of each egg in ounces?

10. Based on his world record speed, how long does it take Howard Helmer to make an omelet?
