<u>Provide Internships for Students</u>: You will provide students work experience by offering a paid or unpaid training experience to high school seniors and/or college students throughout the year.

_____Participate in Job Shadow Days: You will allow students to come to your work site one day a year to shadow employees in different jobs.

<u>Create/Support Scholarships</u>: Your company/organization will participate in CVEP's Pathways to Success scholarship program as a matching partner to help Coachella Valley students get to and through college.

Be a Mentor to High School Students: In their sophomore and junior years, high school students spend time one-onone or in small groups learning about careers from a mentor in programs like "Lunchtime Learners".

<u>Mentor a College Student / MAS – Mentors Advising Students:</u> MAS partners meet with college students once or twice a month to support them in their college studies and career exploration.

Share your Story / Classroom Guest Speakers and Professional Interview Days: Talk with a class about your profession or meet with high school freshmen and sophomore students in small groups to answer questions about how you prepared for your career and what you do at work.

<u>Host Faculty Externship Experiences</u>: You will host a teacher for up to one week to allow a first-hand understanding about how your company works. The teacher will then take that experience back to the classroom to share with students.

Host Career Exploration Programs: Introduce students to your company and the people/careers at your site by hosting a tour of your company.

Serve as a Member of an Industry Council: Attend 2-8 meetings per year to provide input about what should be taught in classes, what equipment should be used and current job/skill demands.

_____Provide Donations of Supplies and Materials for Classrooms: New or "used" supplies provide students "hands on" activities to train on equipment they will use in future jobs in your industry sector.

_____Technical Advice/Assistance to Teachers and Students: Teachers need help with the best software or hardware integration of technology into their programs.
